
WHAT SIZED NEWLY-BUILT RABBIT CAGES ARE REQUIRED?

- Must permit all rabbits to adopt ventral and lateral resting postures. groom, adjust their posture, turn around without obstruction, and move about within the cage/pen.
- Must permit all rabbits to sit upright with their ears fully erect without touching the top of the enclosure.
- Must permit all rabbits in groups to rest on the enclosure floor at the same time, if evenly distributed.
- The cages must be made of suitable material for rabbits and include proper drainage on the floor.
