

# RABBIT CODE OF PRACTICE: TIME FRAME REQUIREMENTS



According to the **Rabbit Code of Practice**, the following equipment/requirements must meet the code by the following dates.

*The Code was published February 15, 2018.*



**AUGUST 1, 2018**

Existing cages/pens must meet the requirements outlined in Table 2 of the **Code of Practice** or must be replaced or modified according to Table 1.



**JANUARY 1, 2021**

A resting mat must be provided to all breeding does and bucks that is large enough to permit the rabbit to sit with all 4 feet in contact with the mat.



**JANUARY 1, 2023**

Stocking density for all growing rabbits must comply with Table 1 of the **Code of Practice**.



**JANUARY 1, 2038**

All cages/pens must meet or exceed the Requirements outlined in Table 1 of the **Code of Practice**.
